
Our College has also introduced "JATAYU HELPLINE NUMBER" in the year 2018 which is available 24*7 for female staff & students.

AND

NANDADEEP FOUNDATION, a Society registered under The Societies Registration Act,1860,(Registration No.: MAH/1565/2018/Thane) through its President Dr. Ketan Santosh Soni (PAN No:BLLPS6429N), residing at 407/408, Alishan Residency CHS, Wayle Nager, Kalyan(W) – 421 301, hereinafter called as 'LICENCEE' (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context of meaning thereof shall mean and include her respective heirs, executors, administrators & assigns) of the party of the SECOND part;

WHEREAS the Licensorsowned, possessed Three rooms on the Third Floor, at Jai Bhagwan Tower, MurlidarAali, near Par Naka, Tilak Chowk, Kalyan West Taluka – Kalyan, District – Thane– 421301, standing on a piece or parcel of land owned by Shree Dnyanraj Mauli Shikshan Seva Mandal, within the limits of Kalyan Dombivli Municipal Corporation and within the Sub – Registration District – Kalyan and Registration District – Thane (the said shop hereinafter is referred to as 'licensed premises').

AND WHEREAS the Licensors were desirous of giving the said Third Floor / licensed premises on leave and license basis and coming to the knowledge of this fact, the Licensee approached the Licensor and requested them to allow the use of the said licensed premises for residential accommodation of Orphan Children / Semi Orphan adopted by the said Nandadeep Foundation only on leave and license basis for the period of Eleven Months from 01.09.2020 to 31.08.2021.

AND WHEREAS the Licensorsare sole owner of the said premises having separate water connection and Electricity Meter No. 020024397140

AND WHEREAS after the discussion between both the parties, the Licensors agreed to give license to the Licensee to use the said Licensed part of the said premises for the residential accommodation of Orphan chindrens only temporarily for 11 months on leave and license basis i.e. from 01.09.2020 to 31.08.2021 at the cost of license fee / compensation

specifically mentioned hereunder in the terms and conditions and the Licensee agreed to take license to use the said licensed premises for business only at the payment of license fee / compensation mentioned hereinunder.

AND WHEREAS the Licensors and the Licensee have executed this Leave and License Agreement on the following terms and conditions:

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

- The Licensors hereby grant leave and license to the Licensee to use and occupy the said licensed premises for the purpose of business temporarily for 11 months from 01.09.2020 to 31.08.2021.
- The Licensee shall pay Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) to the Licensors every month compensation / license fee on or before the 5th day of each calendar month for use of the said licensed premises.
- 3. The Licensee has paid to the Licensors a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/-(Rupees One Lakh only) by cheque without interest towards the refundable security deposit for security of arrears of license fee and damages etc., if any, caused to the said Licensed premises by the Licensee.
- 4. The Licensors shall refund the amount of security deposit without interest to the Licensee after the expiry of said license agreement or if earlier revocation, subject to deduction of arrears of license fee, electricity charges and damages if any caused to the licensed premises.
- 5. The Licensee shall pay Local Body Tax, K.D.M.C. service charges, Electricity Charges, Water Charges, renewal charges and GST if applicable to their part of activities to the concerned authorities regularly as per the provisions of Law and the Rules. However, the municipal taxes of the said Third Floor shall be paid by the Licensors.
- It is hereby declared that there is a relation of Licensors and Licensee only between both the parties.

- The Licensee shall use the said Licensed premises for the purpose of social activities as mentioned aboveand shall not use it for illegal and immoral purpose.
- 8. The Licensee shall not deal or correspond with the Kalyan Dombivli Municipal Corporation, M.S.E.D.Co. Ltd., or any other local authorities in respect of the said licensed premises except for obtaining licenses for the said activities as required under the provisions of Law during the period of license granted under the said agreement.
- 9. The Licensee shall not cause or create nulsance to the surrounding members of the said society/ area and shall keep the said licensed premises clean and shall not throw dirt or garbage in the compound of the society building or in the corridor.
- 10. That this leave and license agreement shall come to an end after the expiry of 11 months and on the expiry of the licensed period, the Licensee shall remove her articles, furniture, bags & baggage from the said licensed premises and deliver vacant and peaceful possession of the said licensed premises to the Licensors.
- The Licensee agrees to maintain the said licensed premises in good condition without causing any damage to it.
- 12. The Licensee shall not keep any illegal, hazardous, explosive articles in the licensed premises.
- 13. The Licensee shall not transfer the Licensee right obtained by them under this agreement to any other third person.
- 14. That during the License period, the Licensors shall have every right to make entry and visit the said licensed premises for inspection of articles, furniture and condition of the said licensed premises during reasonable time.
- 15. It is hereby agreed between the parties hereto that the fixture, fittings, which belong to the Licensors shall continue to remain in the said licensed premises and the Licensors shall / have permitted the

Licensee to use the same under these presents alongwith the use and occupation of the said licensed premises. The Licensee hereby agrees that she shall take all due & reasonable care of all and singular of the said fixture and fittings lying and being in the said premises and belonging absolutely to the Licensors.

- 16. It is hereby agreed between the parties that immediately on the expiry of this License or on earlier surrender or termination thereof, the Licensee shall at its own cost remove themself together with all articles and things, bags & baggage belonging to the Licensee and deliver over to the Licensors peaceful and vacant possession of the said licensed premises and the said fixtures, fittings without any loss or hindrance.
- 17. It is hereby expressly agreed and declared that the Licensee shall use and occupy the said Licensed premises as Licensee and shall not claim any right, interest in the said Licensed premises.
- 18. The Licensee shall bear the electricity charges in respect of use of electricity in the licensed premises during the period of license. The said amount shall be in addition to the license fee agreed to be paid to the Licensors by the Licensee. The Licensee shall pay regularly the electricity bill of the said premises to the concerned authorities and shall not remain in arrears. If the Licensee remains in arrears of electricity bill, the said arrears shall be recovered from the Licensee. Every month the Licensee shall hand over paid electricity bill to the Licensors.
- 19. The expenses for registration, stamp duty etc. of the said document, shall be borne by License. The Licensee shall remain present before the registering authority for the registration of the agreement.
- 20. That the Licensors have allowed the Licensee to use the said licensed premises for residence of Orphan children adopted by the said trustonly but the legal possession of the said premises shall remain with the Licensors.

- 21. It is agreed by and between both the parties that the said leave and license agreement can be terminated by serving one months advance notice at the will and wish of both the parties.
- 22. The Licensee shall not take or obtain rationing card permanently or temporarily on the address of the licensed premises and the said licensed premises or any part of the licensed premises shall not be used for the purpose of residence for herself or for employees engaged in the business.
- 23. The Licensee shall not get any right of tenancy under the said agreement and there is a relation of Licensors and Licensee only. The Licensee shall not claim such right under any circumstances as she is only a Licensee.
- 24. The Licensee shall indemnify and shall keep indemnified the Licensors from any civil, criminal action, liability for non compliance of any legal provision of existing Laws or violation of provisions of Law or Rules etc. while using the said licensed premises for business.
- 25. The Licensors shall not be responsible for load shedding or break down of electricity from the M.S.E.D.Co. Ltd., or meter fault etc. in the said licensed premises. The Licensee shall not repair or deal with repairing matter of electricity or electric meter and if any default is there, the same shall be brought to the notice of the Licensors and the Licensors shall deal with the same and immediately get the meter repaired or replaced. If the Licensors delay or avoid to repair it, they shall be responsible for the loss of the Licensee in the business. The Licensors shall not be responsible for the water shortage from the Corporation as there is water shortage problem in the city of Kalyan.
- 26. The Licensors shall not be responsible for act of natural calamities like flood, fire, lightening, earthquake etc. causing any damage to the Licensee.
- 27. If any damage is caused to the licensed premises due to willful negligence and carelessness of the Licensee, then the Licensee shall indemnify the Licensors in that case. The cost of damage the Licensors shall deduct from the security deposit. The Licensors shall

have right to adjust the arrears of license fee, if any, from the security deposit.

- 28. If the Licensee fails to pay continuously for two months the license fee regularly and commits default in payment of license fee as well as violates any terms and conditions of this agreement, the Licensors shall have a right to terminate the said license exclusively at their own discretion by giving 1 month's notice and in such situation, the Licensee shall vacate the licensed premises and shall remove all her belongings, articles and hand over possession to the Licensors in good condition by clearing all his arrears.
- 29. The Licensors shall inform to the local police authorities about grant of license in the said licensed premises to the Licensee by the Licensors and the Licensee shall remain present in the concerned police station for filling the requisite form.
- 30. If the Licensee avoids, neglects and fails to remain present before the registering authorities for registration of the said document, it will be the sole responsibility of the Licensee and the Licensee shall not get any protection under the provisions of Law.
- 31. The Licensee shall not make out or carry out any permanent alteration or addition or construction or any arrangement internal or external to the licensed premises without the previous written consent of the Licensors.
- 32. The Licensee shall not deal with or correspond with the society / Managing Committee under any reason and the Licensors shall pay the maintenance of the licensed premises to the society / Managing Committee regularly including municipal taxes or any other charges of the said licensed premises.
- 33. The Licensors shall not be responsible and liable for the residents, clients / customers of the Licensee. The Licensors shall not be responsible for the servants, if any, engaged by the Licensee in her business and the Licensee shall keep the register of the employee and comply all the rules, regulations of business and shall carry out business by obtaining requisite permission and licenses from the

concerned authorities and shall maintain requisite registers while carrying out the business as required under the provisions of Law.

- 36. After the expiry of the said agreement or termination of the said agreement, the licenses if any, obtained by the Licensee from any concerned authorities for conducting business in the said premises shall stand cancelled and the Licensee shall inform to the concerned authority about expiry of her agreement or termination from the said licensed premises. The Licensors shall have no objection if the Licensee transfers her own licenses to some other place in the above event. The Licensee shall get cancelled the licenses from the concerned authorities after the termination or expiry of the said agreement, if not transferred on any other address.
- 37. The Licensee herewith declares that the address of the Licensee for correspondence or for issue of letters, notices etc. shall be the above mentioned address in the title and all the correspondence on the said address of the Licensee shall be treated as proper and valid.
- 38. If the Licensee avails cable T V facility in the licensed premises, the charges of cable T V facility shall be paid to the concerned service provider by the Licensee.
- 39. The Licensors shall not be responsible for any theft, shop breaking and thereby causing loss to the Licensee and the same shall be always at the risk of the Licensee. The Licensee shall take precaution about the security and safety of her articles and material lying inside the said licensed premises.
- 40. The Licensee if desires or requires shall engage at her own cost security Guard to protect the said premises.
- 41. The Licensee shall have a right to carry out wodden / aluminium partition / furniture / counter which will suit for her business in the said licensed premises.
- 42. The Licensors herewith declare that except the Licensee herein the Licensors have not agreed to let out the said licensed premises to any

other person or firm. There is no any litigation filed or pending in respect of the said licensed premises in any Court.

- 43. The Licensee shall have a right to install her signboard or logo on the front side of the said licensed premises as permitted by Corporation considering the size, length and width. If any permission is required for the same, the Licensors shall issue N.O.C. to the Licensee.
- 45. The possession of the said licensed premises is handed over to the Licensee on the commencement of the license i.e. on 10.09.2019.
- 46. This agreement shall be binding on both the parties and their respective legal heirs.
